We have seen a fair amount of progress at site over the last month, despite the change in the weather and daylight savings. The west storm water vault is almost complete. This took several weeks of work on all the concrete walls and today the hollow-core planks were placed to close-off the top of the vault.

Construction of the surge tank is complete with waterproofing and installing sleeves. The contractor is working diligently on the elevator shaft as well. Concurrently an intricate labyrinth of mechanical and electrical piping was laid out prior to placing vapor barrier and rebar mats for the floor slab. This week the contractor poured concrete for the slab on grade for the gymnasiums as well as the shear walls for the upper level.


