

## What to Expect During Construction

#### • Traffic impacts

- Roadway to remain open, except for the 8-month closure during bridge construction
- 8-month roadway closure between 247th PI SE and Klahanie Dr SE during bridge construction
- Traffic control/flaggers present as well as increased travel time
- Typical work schedule
  - Monday-Friday, 9:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
  - During road closure Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-8 p.m.
  - Optional Saturday work 9 a.m.-6 p.m.
- Temporary construction impacts
  - Noise, dust, and vibrations
  - Truck and equipment traffic





## Detour During Bridge Construction


- The official detour route is Issaquah-Pine Lake Rd SE and SE 32nd St/SE Issaquah-Beaver Lake Rd
- Klahanie Dr SE will remain accessible from the west, east, and north
- Project haul routes will be in place
- Continuous traffic monitoring throughout the area during construction





# Managing Construction Impacts

- Traffic management tools will include:
  - Temporary roundabout at the intersection of 256th Ave SE and SE Issaquah-Beaver Lake Rd
  - Temporary traffic circle at the intersection of 247th Pl SE and SE 45th Way
  - Extending the curb at the SE Klahanie Blvd and 244th Pl SE intersection and the SE Klahanie Blvd and Klahanie Park
