- Study Potential Sites/Apply Concept Drawings during Feasibility Study





Also Known as "Design-Bid-Build"


What is GC/CM?

- GC/CM = General Contractor/Construction Manager
- <u>Alternative contracting method</u> allowing for a collaborative approach between the owner, the architect, and the general contractor.
- As of 2007 all public agencies are eligible to <u>apply</u> to use GC/CM.
- This is not "design-build."





What is GC/CM?



The Pros

- More Influence over Selection of GC/CM (Price and Qualifications)
- Early Troubleshooting
 - Cost-Estimating
 - Value Engineering
 - Scheduling Analysis
 - Constructability Review
 - Document Checks
- GC/CM has a Financial Stake in Project
 - Max Construction Cost
 - Shared Risk
- Practical Approach for Complex Projects
- GC/CM Projects are On-Time and On Budget






The Cons

- Higher A/E Costs
 - Additional Design Review
 - Multiple Bid Packages
- Higher Overhead Costs

 Ex. City of Lynnwood
 ≈ \$25 Million Renovation Project
 ≈ \$630k to GC/CM
 + Add'l Consulting Fees
- Managing Shared Risk




Why discuss this now?

- Staff are Recommending GC/CM
- Have to commit to GC/CM before we begin design.
- Allow time to prepare an application and to obtain approval to use GC/CM.
- Secure funding for project.
- Hire a GC/CM expert and train staff.


Aquatics – Leisure Pools




















