NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on the 23rd day of August, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance: 2022-0303, which will determine whether Issaquah Park and Recreation Service Area is inactive and whether it should be dissolved. A public hearing is planned for this proposed ordinance to be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, Room 1001, Seattle, Washington; and/or the hearing may be held remotely on Zoom.
