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The work provides for the construction of one fish passable 14 foot span by 9.4 foot rise by 52 foot long concrete box culvert under East Lake Sammamish Parkway (ELSP) and approximately 100 linear feet of stream realignment adjacent to the culvert within the Ebright Creek channel. Two bid schedules include:

Schedule A1 – Culvert Replacement (Base Bid):

Schedule A1 includes removal and replacement of the existing two 30-inch concrete pipe culverts under East Lake Sammamish Parkway (ELSP) with a fish passable 14 foot span by 9.4 foot rise by 52 foot long concrete box structure under ELSP. Schedule A1 also includes streambed construction within the culvert, pavement restoration with HMA including concrete panel replacement, installation of fencing, clearing and grubbing, and additional grading and excavation of approximately 100 linear feet of constructed stream channel adjacent to the culvert with large woody material installation. The work also includes temporary traffic control, temporary erosion and sediment control, temporary stream diversion, planting preparation, preparation and implementation of storm water

pollution prevention plan, installation of temporary staging area, landscape restoration, and mitigation plantings.

Schedule A2 – Water and Sewer (Base Bid):

Schedule A2 includes temporary and permanent utility bypass work for water and sanitary sewer including relocation of water main, casing and relocation of the existing gravity sewer, and installation of additional casing pipe for sanitary sewer.

All bidders are invited to an optional Pre-Bid Field Meeting to observe staging and culvert replacement area existing conditions on public and private property. Information is as follows:

Date: March 3, 2021

Time: 10:00 am (PST)

Location: East Lake Sammamish Parkway (ELSP) 2,000-ft south of the intersection of ELSP and Louis Thompson Road.

Parking: ELSP roadway shoulder/gravel parking area, closest address 125 East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE

The work shall be completed within 84 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction shall be performed in compliance with the Contract Documents for this project and any addenda issued thereto which are on file at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Sammamish, Washington.

At the time and date stated above, the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Specifications. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, money order, or bid bond payable to the "City of Sammamish" of value not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.
