Re: Response to Request for Qualifications/Proposed Approach Questions

The following questions were submitted to the City by the April 27, 2018 deadline as noted in the Request for Qualifications/Proposed Approach (RFQ/PA).

- 1. Could you please clarify if the City is looking for a preliminary version of the Project Approach (PA) as part of the Phase I section of the SOQ due May 8th, or will that only be required as part of Phase II?**
 - a. Project teams should only submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) as described in section VI (page 3-4) of the RFQ. The City will review and rank each SOQ based on how well the proposal meets the criteria described in Section VII.

Submitting a Proposed Approach will be a requirement of Phase II

- 2. The RFQ references this [page](#) for more information, and we found it helpful to review the memorandums and presentation materials. Is the actual feasibility study and background information (such as geotechnical) analysis available for review? There are some past documents on the City's website related to Town Center, but we want to be sure we are referencing the most recent and most complete information.**
 - a. The Sammamish Town Center Regional Stormwater Analysis, dated 3/23/2017 summarizes the work that was completed as part of the feasibility phase of the project. This analysis has been posted to the project page listed below.
