**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON,
RATIFYING, CONFIRMING AND DECLARING AS CITY OF
SAMMAMISH PUBLIC STREETS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY CERTAIN
PUBLIC STREETS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN THE PLAT OF
INGLEWOOD**

WHEREAS, a portion of the City of Sammamish is known as “Inglewood” by virtue of the Plat of Inglewood recorded on July 30, 1889, immediately prior to Washington being granted status as a state within the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, in 1965, several roads, streets, avenues and/or places within Inglewood were physically constructed, deeded and dedicated to King County, and accepted to be maintained as part of the King County Road System by resolution of the then-King County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the King County Resolutions accepting the Inglewood roads, streets, avenues and/or places are attached as Exhibit A to this Sammamish City Council Resolution, and include the following:

- King County Resolution No. 29861, adopted April 19, 1965 (accepting 207th Avenue NE from NE 8th Street to NE 9th Street);
- King County Resolution No. 29862, adopted April 19, 1965 (accepting 207th Place NE extending 518 feet southerly from NE 11th Street);

- King County Resolution No. 30576, adopted August 30, 1965 (accepting 207th Avenue NE from NE 9th Street to NE 11th Street; NE 11th Street from 207th Place NE to 207th Avenue NE; and 210th Avenue NE extending 832 feet south from NE 11th Street); and

WHEREAS, the contemporaneous aerial photograph attached as Exhibit B shows that the above-listed roads, as well as additional segments, were physically constructed by July 10, 1965; and

WHEREAS, Lots 8, 9, 28, and 29, and portions of Lots 7 and 30, Block 45 of the Plat of Inglewood, were conveyed by American Pacific Corporation to King County via Quit Claim Deed recorded on February 4, 1970 under Auditor's File No. 6616727, as right-of-way for NE 9th Place, which is now known as NE 8th Place; and

WHEREAS, the roads, streets, avenues, and places identified in the King County Resolutions, aerial photograph, or deed described above are shown on the map attached as Exhibit C to this Resolution, and are referred to collectively as the "Inglewood Public Streets"; and

WHEREAS, King County maintained the Inglewood Public Streets from their construction and dedication in 1965 up to and through the incorporation of the City of Sammamish on August 31, 1999; and

WHEREAS, by operation of law, pursuant to RCW 35A.02.005 and RCW 35.02.180, the ownership of the Inglewood Public Roads reverted to the City of Sammamish and became City streets as of the official date of incorporation on August 31, 1999; and

WHEREAS, since the date of incorporation, the City of Sammamish has maintained the Inglewood Public Streets by providing various maintenance services, including by way of example street sweeping, snow plowing, pothole repairs, sign maintenance, vegetation management, tree and debris removal, street lighting, and related services, while also providing public safety services along the Inglewood Public Streets, including police, fire, emergency medical, and other services; and

WHEREAS, the Sammamish City Council is authorized under RCW 35A.11.020, 35A.47.020, and chapters 35.68 through 35.79 RCW to acquire, own, improve, maintain, protect, restore, regulate, use, and beautify, among other things, streets, roads, alleys, other public ways within the City of Sammamish; and

WHEREAS, the Sammamish City Council desires to resolve recent questions and ambiguities regarding the status of the Inglewood Public Streets and clearly state the Council's intention to continue providing such public maintenance and public safety services on the Inglewood Public Streets to the same extent as provided on other City public streets and rights-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Inglewood Public Streets Declared City Rights-of-Way. The streets, roads, avenues, places, alleys and/or other rights-of-way depicted on Exhibit C, and referred to herein collectively as the "Inglewood Public Streets," are declared to be public streets and rights-of-way of the City of Sammamish. The prior acceptance of the Inglewood Public Streets into the King County Road System and subsequent maintenance of them as public streets by King County and, since incorporation, by the City of Sammamish, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. Inglewood Public Street Maintenance Shall Continue. The City has historically maintained these Inglewood Public Streets and will continue to do so into the future, including providing public safety and related services over said Streets to the same degree as other public

streets and rights-of-way within the City of Sammamish, as set forth in the City's biennial budget as the same is adopted and amended from time to time.

Section 3. **Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or work of this Resolution should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court or competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Resolution, nor its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.



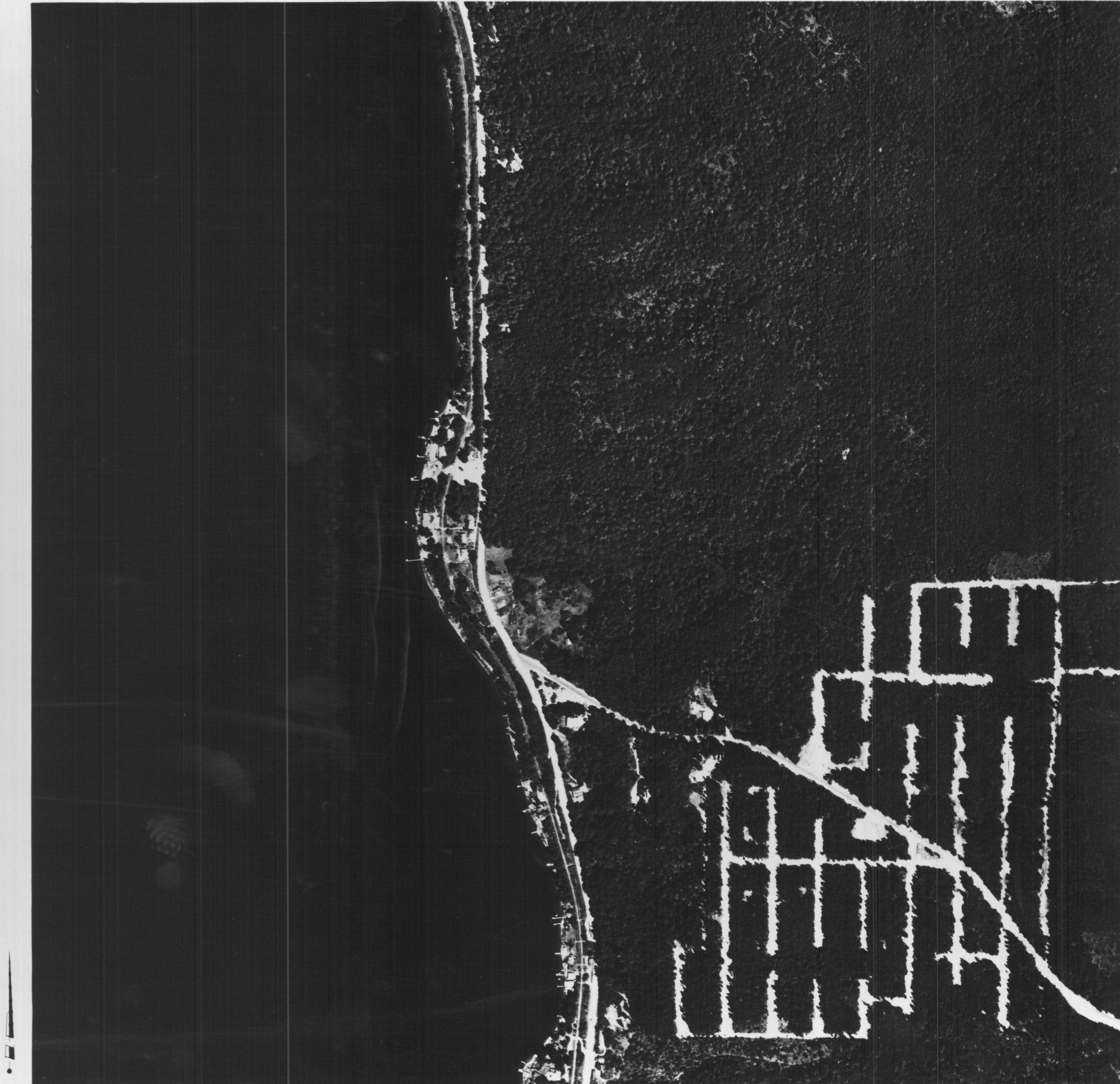
