



Sammamish 2018 Fall Recycle Event

October 13, 2018 9am to 3pm

NEW LOCATION: Sunny Hills Elementary School



Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



- TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$2.00 for each tire on a rim. \$5 for each large truck tire and \$15 for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.
- LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.
- MATTRESSES -** Mattresses and box springs, any size. \$15 per mattress and \$15 per box spring (cash only). Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.
- STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS -** White styrofoam blocks. Packing peanuts (any color). No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Packing peanuts: please keep in box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.
- HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. \$15 (cash only).
- PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. \$5 (cash only).
- CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$28 (cash only) for each refrigerator or freezer. \$33 (cash only) for each household air conditioner. Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.
- APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Household appliances, auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. \$5 for each water heater (cash only). Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. No light fixture ballasts or sealed drums accepted. Any item that contains gas or oil will be rejected.
- ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones (**remove personal information**) and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box for more information.

- These household wastes:**
- No motor oil, antifreeze, filters
 - No TV sets or computer monitors
 - No paper shredding service
 - No scrap wood/bulky wood
 - No construction/demolition debris
 - No garbage
 - No furniture
 - No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
 - No window glass

- These hazardous wastes:**
- No paint of any kind
 - No cleaning products
 - No pesticides/herbicides
 - No solvents and thinners
 - No household chemicals
 - No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays). There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. **No latex paint is accepted.** Visit www.hazwastehelp.org for more information.

FREE recycling of computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions - visit 1800recycle.wa.gov for an authorized E-Cycle Washington location. You may drop off computers, computers monitors, laptops, and TVs for free at the following E-Cycle locations: Value Village Issaquah (5530 East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE, Unit 606-1, Issaquah, WA, 98029, 425-392-2249 and Goodwill Sammamish Highlands Donation Center (behind Safeway at NE 8th St & 228th Ave NE, Sammamish, WA, 98074, (206) 329-1000). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities/sizes accepted are limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.
