The City of Sammamish is pleased to announce the release of a new pilot program for inspections in the field. We are offering virtual inspections (via GoToMeeting) to be used for certain types of occupied structures. In an effort to reduce the spread of the Coronavirus/COVID-19, certain inspections may be completed virtually. Using interactive technology, staff will participate in a live session with the installer or homeowner to complete the inspection. Our goal is to continue to keep as many inspection services operational during this time without compromising the health and safety of our staff and community.

Know the Requirements

A virtual inspection allows the Inspector to remotely view the site using a webcam controlled by you. For this to work you must be able to meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Internet Access
- ✓ Device with webcam (iPad, iPhone, Smartphone or Tablet)
- ✓ Download GoToMeeting App (available at the App Store, Google Play, and Window Store)

Is a Virtual Inspection Right for You?

During the pilot program the following inspections may be completed virtually.

- Final inspection for homeowners as determined by staff
- Re-inspections
- Water-heater replacement
- Furnace replacements

After you request an inspection on www.MyBuildingPermit.com, staff will follow-up and work with you to determine if a virtual inspection is the right fit.
