## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted at Eastside Catholic High School:

- TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for each passenger tire on rim. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.
- CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- MATTRESSES** - Mattresses and box springs, any size. **\$15 per mattress and \$15 per box spring (cash only). Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.**
- PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 (cash only).**
- PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$15 (cash only).**
- BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. No leaves, grass, branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal. Do not need to remove nails from wood.

**PLEASE NOTE: HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to donation locations in the local area. CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND ACCEPTING MATERIAL.**

## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted at Mary Queen of Peace Church:

- ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers.
- TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).
- REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$30 (cash only) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (cash only) will be charged for each household air conditioner. Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.**

**E-Cycle Washington**

**FREE recycling of computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions - visit [1800recycle.wa.gov](http://1800recycle.wa.gov) for an authorized E-Cycle Washington location. You may drop off computers, computers monitors, laptops, and TVs for free at the following E-Cycle locations: Value Village Issaquah (5530 East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE, Issaquah, WA, 98029, 425-392-2249 and Goodwill Sammamish Highlands Donation Center (behind Safeway at NE 8th St & 228th Ave NE, Sammamish, WA, 98074, (206) 329-1000). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities/sizes accepted are limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.**



**These household wastes:**

- No paint of any kind
- No scrap metal/appliances
- No Styrofoam
- No Paper Shredding
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

**These hazardous wastes:  
NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND  
ANTIFREEZE**

- No oil based paint
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents or thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products

**Household hazardous wastes** can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32<sup>nd</sup> Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays). There is a 50 gallon total waste limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. **No latex paint is accepted.** Visit [www.hazwastehelp.org](http://www.hazwastehelp.org) for more information.

In addition, start backyard composting with a **compost bin** to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste contains mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left.



Worm bin composting is an efficient way to convert kitchen scraps into nutrient-rich compost for your garden. Simple to assemble and can be stored in or outside. Made in the US and constructed from high quality recycled plastic-\$25 each.
