Will the City accept a lower limit for the Professional Liability insurance, i.e., \$1million per claim and \$1million policy aggregate limit?	After further review, the City believes that \$1 million per claim and \$1 million aggregate would be adequate.
Will the scope of work be limited to planning and land use review or does the City expect the consultants provide technical expertise such as for civil or environmental review?	<p>Yes, the scope is limited to planning and land use review.</p> <p>Civil review is done through a separate contract with the City’s Public Works department and there is a separate RFP for Environmental Review Support Services (see <a href="#">Current News section of the City of Sammamish website</a>).</p>
I wanted to confirm if the requested services for this RFP is related to planning or engineering services, or both?	The requested services are limited to planning.
Will the City be contracting separately for traffic engineering and/or geotechnical engineering review, or is the City looking for those disciplines to be included in this proposal?	<p>The City is not looking for those disciplines to be included in this proposal.</p> <p>However, geotechnical services are included as part of the scope for the Environmental Review Support Services RFP (see <a href="#">Current News section of the City of Sammamish website</a>).</p>
