



**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (SEPA)
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)**

SDT2024-00066 Louis Thompson Road Tightline Project

Date of Issuance: March 18, 2024

Project Description: The project proposes to upgrade the existing ditch and culvert system on Louis Thompson Road NE to a tightline system that includes a storm sewer pipe and structures for the collection and conveyance of the runoff. Stub-outs to collect stormwater from side streets will be installed when needed, and the existing outfalls within the project site will be maintained.

Flow control facilities will be included in the design based on the amount of impervious surface that may be added for potential non-motorized improvements. Non-motorized improvements to be considered as additions to the project scope include sidewalk, bike lane, and landscape strip features.

In addition, the project will also replace approximately 3,200 lineal feet of water main with 8" Ductile Iron water main, and add an additional 1,290 lineal feet of water main and/or service connections, along Louis Thompson Rd NE within the existing roadway prism between 205th Ave NE and 210th Ave NE.

Appeals must be submitted in writing with the appropriate filing fee and received by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the appeal period (April 8, 2024) at City Hall, located at 801 228th Ave SE, Sammamish, WA, 98075.
