PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (SSDP) to allow the construction of a new 470 square feet fixed pile dock and boat lift without canopy. The subject property is located in the R-4 zoning district and Lake Sammamish Shoreline Residential Designation.

SEPA THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) was issued on January 4, 2024.

The final decision of the City, as issued by the City of Sammamish Hearing Examiner, is appealable to the Washington State Shoreline Hearings Board in accordance with RCW 90.58.180 and SMC 25.08.090.
