**INVITATION**

The City of Sammamish is seeking a bid for furnishing, cutting to length, and storing steel soldier piles for future construction of a soldier pile wall. The work includes procurement of steel shapes meeting WSDOT requirements, cutting to specified lengths, readiness for pickup, and loading at the Supplier's facility; transport beyond loading at the Supplier's facility is excluded and performed by others during the specified delivery window. The formal Invitation to Bid will be released through the City's procurement platform, Bidnet. Sealed bids will be received by the City of Sammamish through Bidnet.

Please submit all bid materials no later than **February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 1:00 PM PST**
