Project Description: The Sammamish Transit Plan (Transit Plan) is a planning document that evaluates the existing and future transit system in Sammamish, taking into consideration access to transit, transit speed and reliability, and transit-related safety.

In order to keep the Transit Plan current and active, it is intended that it will be updated every five years. It is anticipated that each update will include a description of the changes to the regional and local transit system, a reevaluation of project needs and an update of project costs.
