Notice is hereby given that the City of Sammamish Hearing Examiner will convene a public hearing on November 3, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, regarding the East Lake Sammamish Trail Segment 2B - City of Sammamish File #SSDP2016-00415. The public hearing will take place at 801 – 228th Ave SE, Sammamish, WA (City Hall Council Chambers). If the hearing is not able to be completed by approximately 5 p.m. on the first day, it will be continued as needed to November 6, 7, 8, 9, and 20, 2017 which have been reserved as additional hearing dates. The hearing will be continued at the end of each day only as needed; this notice is not a guarantee that the hearing will need to be continued to all of the listed days.

Notice is further given that direct public testimony will be heard beginning at 1:00 p.m. on the first hearing day; the hearing will return to regular order at the completion of direct public testimony. There will not be a second opportunity for direct public testimony. In accordance with Rule of Procedure 312(a) time limits will be imposed on public testimony: A person testifying as a spokesperson for an organized group will be allotted 5 minutes; all other persons will be allotted three minutes. RoP 312(a) will be enforced: time is not cumulative and may not be traded or donated to another speaker; and testimony shall not be repetitious. Submittal of written hearing statements is encouraged, especially if you have lengthy or complex information to convey. Duplication of previously submitted comments is unnecessary as all such written comments will be entered into the hearing record. Written comments will be accepted until the end of the hearing.

NOTE ON PARKING AT CITY HALL:

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL

The King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks is proposing to improve 3.5 miles of the existing soft-surface interim East Lake Sammamish Trail, extending from SE 33rd Street to Inglewood Hill Road. This interim trail will be widened to 12 feet of paved surface with 2-foot gravel shoulders and a 1-foot clear zone on

In conjunction with the trail widening, associated activity will take place which includes: earthwork; drainage improvements related to the trail; culvert replacements to improve fish passage; construction of rest areas with benches; improved intersections and sight triangles; mitigation and habitat enhancement; landscaping and fencing; and access and traffic control (bollards, striping, signage, etc.). The subject properties are located in the R-4 zone and in close proximity to Lake Sammamish which is a Shoreline of Statewide Significance. This proposal is located within the Lake Sammamish Shoreline Residential Environment Designation. *A copy of the Staff Report and Exhibits can be found here:*

PROPOSAL AND HEARING DETAILS

<u>Decision Required:</u> Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (SSDP) – Type 4 Decision

<u>Decision Authority:</u> City of Sammamish Hearing Examiner on Community Development Department Recommendation

<u>Recommendation to Hearing Examiner:</u> Conditional Approval of the Shoreline Substantial Development Permit

<u>Project Review:</u> The applicant (King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks) applied for the above project on October 19, 2016. The City deemed the application complete for processing on December 13, 2016. On December 28, 2016, the City issued a Notice of Application with a 30-day comment period.

Following completion of project review this Notice of Public Hearing and Staff Report is issued on September 29, 2017 by the following means: mailed notice to property owners within 2,000 feet of the subject site, two signs posted on the subject site, emailed notification through the Government Alert System, and by placing a legal notice in the local newspaper. The 30-day public comment period for this proposal was December 28, 2016 through January 27, 2017.

The Site is located west of East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE and East Lake Sammamish Parkway NE (the "Parkway") between SE 33rd Street and Inglewood Hill Road in Sammamish, WA within portions of Sections 06, 07, & 08, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M. and Sections 29, 31, & 32, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

The final decision of the City, as issued by the City of Sammamish Hearing Examiner, is appealable to the Washington State Shoreline Hearings Board in accordance with RCW 90.58.180 and SMC 25.08.090.
