ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID FOR THE GENERAL
CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR SAMMAMISH
LANDING ADA ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS AT
SAMMAMISH LANDING PARK

The City of Sammamish is soliciting bid proposals from contractors for the construction of the Sammamish Landing ADA Access Improvements at Sammamish Landing Park. The work includes, but is not limited to, the construction of structural earth walls supporting cement concrete sidewalk pedestrian access ramps, pedestrian railing, chain link fencing, foundation for a pre-fabricated restroom, road pavement widening, cement concrete curb and gutter, drainage improvements, permanent signing, electrical system installation, channelization, surveying, traffic control, temporary stairway, coordination with restroom building contractor and utilities, and driveway repair. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$750,000.

Sealed bid proposals, plainly marked "City of Sammamish, Sammamish Landing ADA Access Improvements" on the outside of the mailing envelope, addressed to the City of Sammamish, 801 228th Avenue SE, Sammamish, WA 98075, will be accepted until 2:00 pm on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. Bid proposals may also be hand-delivered in person to the main desk on the first floor of City Hall by the required date and time. Proposals delivered after the posted deadline will not be considered for selection. No faxed, telephone or emailed proposals will be accepted.

A non-mandatory, informational site visit will be conducted on Wednesday, April 19, 2017 at 10:00 am at the project site, located at 4607 East Lake Sammamish Parkway NE in the City of Sammamish. All interested parties shall meet at the parking lot, to be escorted to the project site. Attendance is recommended and any questions will be answered at that time. The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested contractors with any background information which may be beneficial in preparing a bid proposal.
