RE: Zackuse Creek Fish Passage and Stream Restoration Project

Dear Resident:

You are invited to the second public meeting on the Zackuse Creek Fish Passage and Stream Restoration project. The City will construct a new fish passable culvert under East Lake Sammamish Parkway located about 900 feet south of Louis Thompson Hill Road. The project also includes the creation of 400 linear feet of stream restoration designed to provide kokanee habitat for spawning upstream of the culvert.

We are also excited to share we with you that the City and King County are in negotiations to combine the construction of the Zackuse Creek culvert under the King County trail and under Shore Lane with the City's fish passage project. We anticipate reduction of public costs on both projects, reduction in overall construction time, and the result of all lower Zackuse Creek fish passage barriers removed by the end of 2018.

At this meeting, the project team will discuss the proposed combined designs and receive your comments and feedback. Construction will begin in June 2018.
