The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' letter dated November 30, 2020, approving coverage under Nationwide Permit (NWP) #14 for the above project.

Upon review of the JARPA received May 1, 2020, Ecology has determined that the project meets the requirements for Washington State 401 Water Quality Certification and Coastal Zone Management Act Consistency under NWP #14. Therefore, an Individual Section 401 certification will <u>not</u> be required for this project and you may proceed as directed by the Corps.

Any changes to your project that would impact water quality should be submitted in writing to Ecology before work begins for additional review.

This letter does not exempt you from other requirements of federal, state, and local agencies.
