Consideration of the Beaver Lake Management District Renewal

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sammamish City Council will hold a Public Hearing to consider a Resolution to renew the Beaver Lake Management District.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL: The City Council will consider the renewal of the Beaver Lake Management District No. 1 (“District”) for the period of 2027-2036, a plan that was initiated due to resident interest in the long-term protection of Beaver Lake. The City Council previously passed legislation that authorized affected property owners to vote on the formation of the Beaver Lake Management District No. 1 in 2001, established the District in 2006, and renewed the District in 2016 for the current period of 2017-2026. The Beaver Lake Basin contains significant resources, including the highest quality of wetlands, streams, and lakes.

The City Council passed a Resolution of Intent to Renew the District (R2026-1139) on March 17, 2026. The District is proposed to raise \$733,390 from 2027 to 2036 to fund a series of lake management actions, including water quality monitoring, vegetation management, and administration. This revenue will be raised through annual assessments of waterfront and non-waterfront parcel owners inside the proposed district boundary. Waterfront property owners (Zone 1, 126 parcels) will pay \$320 per year, while non-waterfront parcels (Zone 2, 1012 parcels) will be assessed \$33 per year.

HEARING SCHEDULE: Public testimony will be taken by the City Council on May 5, 2026, at a public hearing. The Public Hearing will be part of a City Council Regular Meeting, which will start at 6:30 pm on May 5, 2026, at Sammamish City Hall.
