

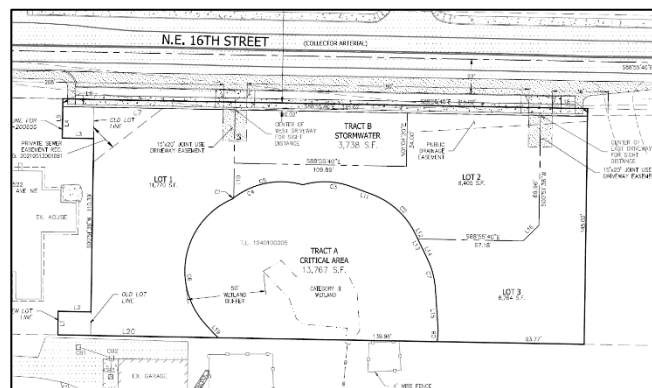
NOTICE OF DECISION
SRIRAM SHORT SUBDIVISION | FILE NO.: PSHP2019-00412

DATE OF NOTICE: April 4, 2022

APPEAL PERIOD: April 4, 2022, to April 25, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 4, 2022, **APPROVAL** was granted by the Department of Community Development for the Sriram Preliminary Short Subdivision. Public notice has been provided via mailed notice to property owners within 1,000 feet of the subject site, a sign posted on the subject site, and publication of a legal notice in the local newspaper.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposal is to subdivide 1.10-acre site into 3 lots for single family residential development. Two tracts are proposed within this development. TRACT A will be designated as a critical area tract, while TRACT B will be used for stormwater management. The property is zoned R4 and contains a Category III wetland.
