



**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (SEPA)
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)**

SDT2026-00352 - SE 6TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS PHASE A

Date of Issuance: August 4, 2026

Project Description: The City will construct the south half of the SE 6th Street roadway between 222nd Place SE and 224th Avenue SE. The work will connect to and match the previously completed north-side improvements built by the adjacent Brownstone West and Brownstone East developments. Project elements include roadway and intersection upgrades, stormwater conveyance and detention, water-quality treatment facilities, street lighting, pedestrian enhancements, urban design features, and associated landscaping.

These materials collectively provide adequate environmental analysis to support this determination. The DNS is issued in accordance with WAC 197-11-340(2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issuance (WAC 197-11-340(2)(c); WAC 197-11-502(3)(b)). Public comments on the DNS may be submitted in writing, and must be provided in hard copy or by email to the SEPA Responsible Official no later than August 18, 2026, at 5:00 pm. Pursuant to SMC 21.09.030.L.1.d, no local appeal of a DNS is available.
