The City of Sammamish is seeking qualifications from experienced consultants for updating the City's Addendum to the King County Surface Water Design Manual. The Project will include reviewing and revising the current stormwater code and stormwater addendum to the new 2026 KCSWDM; with the overarching goals of improving how these requirements are implemented and communicated with the public, increase protection of Sammamish's natural ecosystems, and to add additional water quality Best Management Practices to meet the City's nutrient removal goals. The Request for Qualifications (RFQ) will be released through the City's procurement platform, Bidnet. Sealed bids will be received by the City of Sammamish through Bidnet.
