

### ABOUT SHORELINE SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMITS

A Shoreline Substantial Development permit is required for all development that doesn't meet the exemptions in WAC 173-27-040.

### **APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS**

A Shoreline Substantial Development Permit is a Type 4 decision subject to a hearing and decision by the Hearing Examiner based on the recommendation of the Director. The Hearing Examiner then forwards the application to the Department of Ecology and the state Attorney General for further review and approval or disapproval.
