### WHAT IS A WALKING SCHOOL BUS?

A walking school bus is a walking group lead by a parent volunteer. These groups can help increase visibility of students walking and a parent volunteer can help to make sure everyone is practicing safe walking habits. You can find more information at this link: www.walkingschoolbus.org

#### ARE PARENTS CHECKED FOR DRIVING RECORD, BACKGROUNDS, ETC.?

No, the SchoolPool program just identifies families who may live near each other and are traveling to school around the same time. It is the responsibilities of each family to discuss arrangements.

## IS MY INFORMATION, OR MY CHILD'S INFORMATION, MADE PUBLIC?

No, only parents who are approved by school administrators are granted access to the website. The website is password protected and cannot be accessed by other users of icarpool or the general public.
