Adoption of the Climate Action Plan for the City of Sammamish

Description of Proposal:

The Climate Action Plan (CAP) is the City's comprehensive strategy to address climate change over the next 30 years. The CAP aims to promote sustainable practices and increase energy efficiency through specific actions. The ultimate goal is to build a more resilient community that can adapt to changing environmental conditions while reducing the carbon footprint of the city.

Proponent: City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development

Location of Proposal: The Climate Action Plan would be applied within the City's legal boundaries.

Lead Agency: City of Sammamish

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after a review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
