## STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (SEPA) DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

SDT2023-00816 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PROS) Plan

Date of Issuance: November 22, 2023 The City of Sammamish 2024 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PROS) Plan is an **Project Description:** update to the 2018 PROS Plan and incorporates the feedback from an extensive community engagement process conducted in 2023. The PROS Plan gives an overview of the City's park system planning, a current inventory of park facilities, analysis of current recreation and maintenance efforts, and an assessment of their existing conditions. The plan identifies benefits of the parks system; lists park goals, objectives, and policies; and proposes a six-year schedule of park projects involving planning, design, implementation, and renovations. The purpose of the plan is to identify a park system throughout Sammamish that addressed citizen needs, interests, and environmental concerns. **Applicant/Proponent:** Shelby Perrault, Parks Project Manager **Project Location:** Entire jurisdictional boundary of the City of Sammamish Lead Agency: City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development
