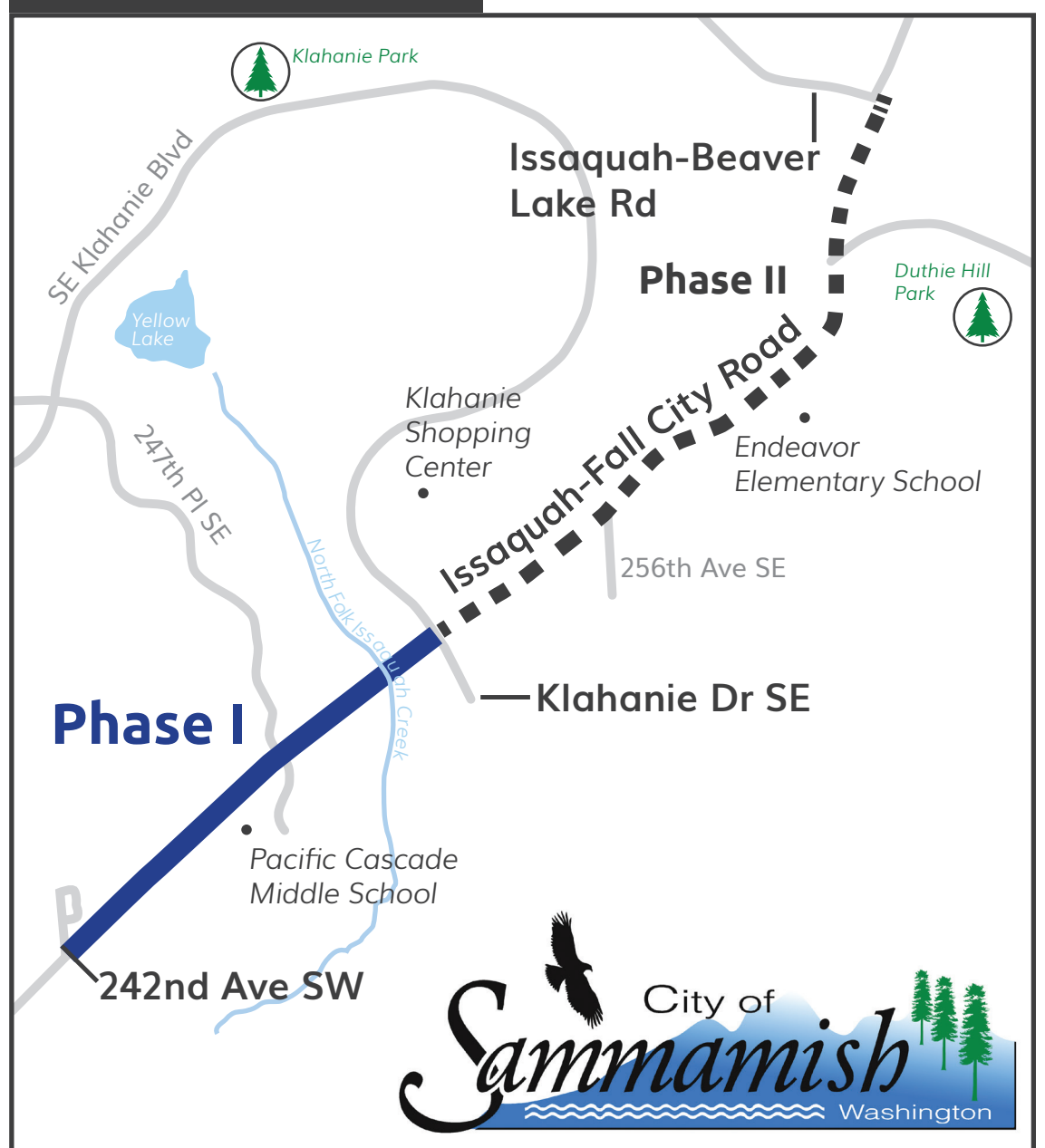
Join us at the workshop to:
